

Cutting and sticking

If you cut a file into two pieces (blue button beneath) then when you paste the files back together, you get back the original file.

- 1 Create a folder on your desktop with the name test
- 2 Place in this folder anywhere an .srt file called film.srt
- 3 Put this file also on your desktop. (Control file)
- 4 Read the file in the folder with the program.
- 5 Cut the file on title number 100 (lower blue button).
In the information section you can now see how the file is called. (Film CD2.srt)
- 6 See these files with notepad. (film.srt and film CD2.srt)
- 7 We will now stick these parts together.
- 8 Paste film CD2.srt to film.srt
- 9 Compare with the notepad the files film.srt in the folder and film.srt on the desktop.

It happens that if you have two srt files downloaded, these files are not exactly good. The latest title from first text file 1 is the first title of the second text file 2. Before you stick these parts together you must cut off the first title of file 2. To cut off the first title use the top blue button.

If you have two srt files and two avi files it can happen that there is too much text in a file and in the other file is too less. In this case, you should first paste these files together. Afterward you cut it on the right place.

To much text in one and too little in the other file

Given: film1.avi film2.avi and film1.srt film2.srt

1. Read film1.srt in the program.
2. Paste film2.srt to adopt.
3. Make subtitles for film1.avi well.
4. Look at how long the player takes film1.avi.
5. Enter this time in the search area. The program now shows the title track of which just does not come film1.avi (check it here)
6. Enter the title number in the cutting section and press the blue bottom button.
7. Film1.srt is now ready.
8. Now read the file in Film1 CD2.srt.
9. Write this file away the name film2.srt
10. Read and check film2.srt and make it proper.
